

Swiftly through the Dutch ports



Brexit affects you as well!

New rules are in effect in Dutch ports as of the 1st of January 2021

- Always customs formalities
- Only access to terminals after digital pre-notification of customs documents via Portbase

Please note! As a transporter, be sure to make clear agreements with your customers as to who will be responsible for arranging the customs formalities and submitting the pre-notifications via Portbase from the 1st of January 2021. Otherwise, you will come to a standstill in the port as a carrier. You will not be granted access to the ferry terminal.

Choose from 2 solutions:

- 1. Inform your customers about the new rules that will be in effect in the port as of 2021. To ensure a smooth process, advise them to immediately start making use of a customs broker.
- 2. Make arrangements with a customs broker so that they will reserve capacity for your customers. Your customers will consequently be able to make use of this party prior to the transport.

Whichever solution you opt for: **spring into action right now!** Inform your customers and/or immediately contact a customs broker. They are experiencing a strong influx of new customers. Go to **fenex.nl**, to select a customs broker.
